IN THE NAME AND BY AUTHORITY OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:

THE GRAND JURY, for the County of McLennan, State of Texas, duly selected, empaneled, sworn, charged, and organized as such at the July Term, A.D., 2003, of the 54th Judicial District Court for said County, upon their oaths present in and to said Court at said term that **CARLTON ERIC DOTSON**, hereinafter styled Defendant, heretofore on or about the 12th day of June, A.D. 2003, and before the presentment of this indictment, in the County and State aforesaid, did then and there intentionally or knowingly cause the death of an individual, namely, **PATRICK DENNEHY**, by shooting him with a firearm,

PARAGRAPH 2

And it is further presented in and to said Court that the said **CARLTON ERIC DOTSON** in the County of McLennan and State aforesaid on or about the 12th day of June, 2003, did then and there, with intent to cause serious bodily injury to an individual, namely, **PATRICK DENNEHY**, commit an act clearly dangerous to human life, to-wit: shooting him with a firearm, that caused the death of said **PATRICK DENNEHY**,
