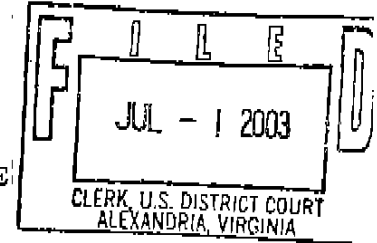

ORDER

On June 30, 2003, a magistrate judge issued an Order Setting Conditions of Release ("Release Order"), which authorized the release of defendant Masoud Ahmad Khan on specific conditions. The United States has filed a Motion to Stay and Revoke Release Order in which it asks that execution of the Release Order be stayed until this Court can rule on its appeal of the Release Order. The Court has since been advised that Pretrial Services will not be able to arrange for monitoring of the defendant until Wednesday, July 2, 2003. Finding, therefore, that the defendant will not be prejudiced by a stay and that the United States might be prejudiced if a stay is not granted, the government's Motion to Stay Release Order is GRANTED, and it is hereby


ORDERED that execution of the Order Setting Conditions of Release be and is stayed pending resolution of the government's Motion to Revoke Release Order; and it is further

ORDERED that oral argument of the government's Motion to Revoke Release Order is scheduled for Wednesday, July 2, 2003 at

4:00 p.m.
